

## Good Afternoon Colleagues and Students:

A group of individuals from across the campus community came together today to compile a list of additional resources available specifically to those CSUSB students and employees who may be impacted by the Blue Cut Fire. Additional information will be provided as it becomes available.

## **HOUSING:**

- The Office of Housing and Residential Life has limited temporary housing available to students and employees impacted by the Blue Cut Fire. Linens will be provided. Those students and employees needing housing should go to the front office at the University Village or call (909) 537-4155 to request temporary housing.
- AirBNB is waiving service fees for those affected by the disaster and checking in between August 16, 2016 and August 30, 2016. If you are in need of housing, know somebody who is, or have a space you'd like to offer for free, please click here: AirBNB Blue Cut Fire Disaster Response

#### FOOD:

- A call for donations is being made by The Den to include food, hygiene/toiletry items, diapers, wipes, formula, pet food, blankets/towels, etc.. They are making up packages for those who are impacted and already staying on campus.
- We have coordinated with Dave Janowski/Sodexo to provide hot meals for those displaced students and employees who are staying in campus housing.
- Gift cards can be donated to The Den at any time.

#### **CLOTHING:**

 A call for donations is being made by the Career Center to clothing for students and employees impacted by the fire. New and gently used clothing, shoes, purses, and backpacks. Packages of new socks and under garments would also be greatly appreciated.

#### **FINANCIAL RESOURCES:**

- We are working with the United Way to confirm the official source where relief funds can be donated. More information will be provided once it is available.
- We know that many of our employees are members of SchoolsFirst Federal Credit Union. As a reminder, they have
  financial relief programs with special terms for members affected by the fire. These may include temporary credit
  limit increases, fee waivers, deferments/payment reductions for loans, waiving early withdrawal penalties on
  certificates of deposit, emergency relief grants and interest free emergency loans as well as other options.
  Members should call a Member Service Specialist at (800) 462-8328, ext. 8059 Monday through Friday, 7:00 AM
  to 7:00 PM and Saturday, 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM. Arrowhead Credit Union offers similar programs.

# **MEDICAL RESOURCES:**

 The Student Health Center (SHC) is open from 7:00 AM to 5:30 PM and walk-in appointments are available to students on campus in need of services. The SHC can be reached at 909-537-5241. A list of additional medical service providers in the area is also attached.

#### **MENTAL HEALTH RESOURCES:**

- Large animals are being sheltered at the San Bernardino County Fairgrounds located at 14800 7th Street,

- Please contact these shelters directly if you have animal carriers, cages, and/or blankets to donate or if you are able to foster any animals rescued.

#### **ALTERNATE TRANSPORTATION RESOURCES**

The card needs to be the newer version with the blue stripe on the back. If anyone needs to update theirs, they can go to the Coyote One office located PL-1108.
